
4th of July Patriotic Parade and Celebration

Dining South of Houston

Those who were raised in the 40's, 50's and 60's will remember how often the big event of the week was a Sunday afternoon drive for a meal at a Restaurant. The days of fast food and dining out every other night had yet to become a reality. Those trips were a joyous occasion of family bonding and new experiences.

In tribute to this historical tradition and the warm memories that linger in many a mind of Shepherd Park Plaza residents, why not consider taking your own Sunday Afternoon Drive to one of the many interesting restaurants south of Houston. As you might suspect, most that shall be mentioned are "on the water" or very near.



As you go down I 45 towards Galveston, why not detour to San Leon. There on the southern most point of the San Leon Peninsula, where the Dickinson and Galveston Bays meet, you can experience the local restaurant called The Topwater Grill, 815 Avenue O. Most of the shrimp and oysters served here are caught by boats that call this dock their home. Additionally, if you are fortunate, you will spot a green monk parakeet. This marina has one of their largest nests in addition to an abundance

Should you continue on I 45 to Galveston you will find The Pelican Rest Marina on the south side of the Causeway Bridge and the north side of Offatts Bayou. This is a post Ike, recently opened facility which is a pleasure to the eye. Additionally, the Marina is home to Number 13, an upscale steakhouse featuring prime steaks and local seafood.


Where 61s Street meets the Seawall, a right turn leads to both Waterman's and The West End Restaurant.

Waterman's, at 14302 Stewart Road, boosts an open kitchen and 100 year old hardwood floors. The upstairs is island formal and the downstairs is an open air bar with casual ambience. From both there are stunning sunset views.

Further down the west end of the island you will find The West End Restaurant, 21706 Burnet Drive in The Sea Isle subdivision. It is about four miles west of Jamaica beach. Again, you will dine or liquid refresh waterside.

Should you opt for some adventure, then you should turn east where 61s meets the Seawall and head to the Bolivar Ferry Landing. Experience the freedom of riding across the Ship Channel on one of the Free Ferries. You might see Dolphins and you are sure to have many a Seagull begging for a crust of bread. When you debark on Bolivar, head to Stingaree Restaurant and Marina, 1295 North Stingaree Road in Crystal Beach on the Intercoastal Waterway. Their motto is "You hook 'em, we cook 'em". Does this give you a clue to the casual and relaxed atmosphere that prevails?

The next time you decide to go out for a meal, why not consider making it a memorable experience!!


