

Long-time Shepherd Park Plaza resident, Jim Worthing, passed away December 5, 2021 at the age of 88. Jim joined the US Navy in 1951, serving our country in submarine duty. He was a long time IBM employee, with his most proud contribution being to the NASA Gemini and Apollo missions. He was responsible for the IBM systems in Mission Control from the start of the Houston Manned Spacecraft Center in 1963 until after the Apollo13 mission was completed. Jim was also active in his community and Church. He lived in the Shepherd Park Plaza neighborhood for 50 years. Jim married the love of his life, Dorothy, in February 1956. He is survived by his wife of 65 years, Dorothy Worthing; son, Roger Worthing and wife Clarissa; granddaughters, Caitlin and Brianna Worthing; brothers, Jerry, Jack, and Mike Worthing.

Prepare for Cold Weather

While this winter season has been quite mild, Winter Storm Uri was not that long ago! Keep in mind the tips below so you are prepared!

- Check the Forecast at weather gov or your favorite weather app, station, etc.: Make checking the forecast part of your regular routine so you'll know when to expect cold weather.
- Weatherproof Your Home. Insulate any water lines that run along exterior walls so your water supply will be less likely to freeze. Caulk and weather-strip doors and windows. Repair roof leaks and cut away tree branches that could fall on your home or other structure during a storm.
- **Protect Your Pets, Livestock, and Other Property:** If you have pets, make sure they have plenty of food and water and are not overly exposed to extreme cold. Take precautions to ensure your water pipes do not freeze. Know the temperature thresholds of your plants.
- **Fill Up the Tank:** Make sure your car or vehicle has at least a half a tank of gas during extreme cold situations so that you can stay warm if you become stranded.
- Install or Check Your Smoke Detector and Carbon Monoxide Detector. Changing your batteries with the daylight saving time change is a good practice.

It's likely that at the end of the growing season your soil is depleted of essential nutrients. Pick up a soil test kit at a local garden center to figure out what you need. Compost is a great way to add nutrients back in to the soil. It also helps to improve moisture retention and drainage. Not sure where to buy? Ask at local stores like Wabash and Joshua's! 

Please leave 3 ft between your bins and any other objects. This gives the trucks room without damage to nearby items.

Reminder about Heavy Trash: TREE waste is picked up in ODD months and JUNK waste in the EVEN months. TREE waste is defined as "clean" wood waste, such as tree limbs, branches, and stumps. Lumber, furniture, and treated wood will NOT be accepted as Tree Waste. JUNK is defined as items such as furniture, appliances, and other bulky material.
