Welcome to SPP, Captain Bender!



Harris County Precinct One Constable Alan Rosen appointed a new member to his Command Staff effective August 27, 2022: Captain Lori Bender.

As a permanent member of the Command Staff, Captain Bender will manage patrol operations, which include Animal Cruelty Investigations, Contract and District Patrol, K-9 Unit, Motorcycle Unit, and Toll Road Patrol. "I'm looking forward to serving our deputies and the community in this new role. I have been given many opportunities and blessings in my life and will do my best to give back," Captain Bender said.

Captain Bender is a native Houstonian. She joined the Houston Police Academy in 1985 and embarked on a 35-year career with the Houston Police Department (HPD). Captain Bender moved up through the ranks as Officer, Sergeant, Lieutenant, Captain and, finally, served as an Assistant Chief. She worked in various capacities over the years as a patrol officer, undercover officer, investigator and supervisor, in the divisions of Patrol, Jail, Operations Command, Auto Theft, Auto Dealers, Mobility Incident Management, Juvenile, Robbery and Training. As an Assistant Chief, Captain Bender managed a Patrol Region consisting of North, Northeast, North Belt, Central,

Kingwood and Traffic Enforcement Divisions. She then oversaw the Organizational Development Command which consists of Recruiting, Training, Employee Services, Risk Management and Psychological Services.

After her career with HPD, Captain Bender spent a year at the Precinct 1 Constable's Office as a Sergeant and developed the Deputy Program at NRG Park. At the Harris County District Attorney's Office, Captain Bender worked on policy development and attained the rank of Captain.

Captain Bender obtained a Bachelor of Business Administration from the University of Houston-Downtown and a Master of Arts in Criminology from the University of Houston-Clear Lake. She is also a graduate of the FBI National Academy and the Police Executive Research Forum, Senior Management Institute of Police.

Located on 19th Street near Shepherd, Moon Rabbit is another recent addition to the neighborhood. If you are craving classics like banh mi or pho, or if you want to try something a little different, Moon Rabbit has something for you. The cocktail list is also fun and interesting. We tried several items on our first visit, and the consensus was that this was the first of many visits. The standouts were the egg rolls, banh xeo tostada with pork belly and shrimp, and the Cornish hen. The crab pockets were also wonderful.

A sign of a true winner is that we were already planning what we would get during the next visit.

The servers were knowledgeable and kind, and the restaurant is family friendly. The dining space is open and spacious. Moon Rabbit does have its own parking lot, and if that's full, street parking is also available. The restaurant is usually closed between 3-5pm, so make sure to check the hours before you visit!




SPP Garden Club is getting crafty!




