



Look closely, and you will see drift roses, vinca, Marguerite daisies, rose of Sharon, Salvia, blue daze, snapdragons, purslane, hydrangeas, plumbago, lantana, Indian Hawthorne, and Sasanqua camellias. With such a large array of plants, there is always something blooming in Emily's garden, and it is a haven for bees and butterflies.

Tree waste will be collected every tuesday in June



By request of our collectors, please place bins in the street, not on the sidewalk/curb.

Please leave 3 ft between your bins and any other objects. This gives the trucks room without damage to nearby items.

Reminder about Heavy Trash:

TREE waste is picked up in ODD months and JUNK waste in the EVEN months. TREE waste is defined as "clean" wood waste, such as tree limbs, branches, and stumps. JUNK is defined as items such as furniture, appliances, and other bulky material.
